### The Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Due to the spread of the coronavirus Bishop Toal has directed all parishes within the diocese to implement a number of precautionary measures. Holy Water stoups would be left empty though we should still sign ourselves with the Cross on entering Church. The Sign of Peace has been suspended. We are advised to receive Holy Communion in the hand rather than on the tongue. The distribution of the Chalice is also suspended while the present crisis lasts. Ministers of the Eucharist are asked to thoroughly clean their hands before distributing Holy Communion. It will be advisable for Ministers to take wipes with them to the homes of our sick and housebound. We are invited to pray both for those already suffering because of this virus, and then for God's help that we be protected from all harm.

This weekend we shall be having the Diocesan second collection for Sick and Retired Priests. We are encouraged to be as generous as possible.
