COP26 Information

As we have been hearing on television, social media and other sources the United Nations Conference on the environment is due to take place in Glasgow on 1st – 12th November.

It was anticipated that Pope Francis would be attending the conference. However, the following message has been received from the Scottish Catholic Media Office on behalf of the Bishops Conference of Scotland:

“While Scotland’s Catholic bishops had welcomed the prospect of Pope Francis attending the COP26 Conference in Glasgow, they accept with some sadness the news that he will be unable to attend. The bishops welcome the announcement that Cardinal Parolin will lead the Holy See delegation as an indication of the importance the Church attaches to COP26 and will continue to keep Pope Francis in their prayers.”

A Torchlight Rosary and Procession is due to take place at Carfin Grotto on 31st October at 3.30pm organised by the Vocation Network Scotland to pray for the success of the conference.
