Notice the same idea is liked to the role of Bishops who carry a crozier rather like a shepherd's crook a symbol of them being the chief shepherds within the Diocese. We thank God for his blessings to the Diocese of Motherwell. As in previous years a Novena of prayer for vocations in each of our Scottish Dioceses will take place. A reminder that **Thursday 30th May** is the **Solemnity of the Ascension** and is a **Holy Day of Obligation** for all Catholics. Mass will be celebrated in the parish at **09.30** but please note there will be **no evening Mass** on the feast since Fr Bergin is celebrating Mass in John Ogilvie school in Blantyre at 6.30 pm. The feast of the Ascension heralds the start of the **Novena** (nine days of prayer) in preparation for the **Feast of Pentecost**. Pentecost was one of the three major Jewish celebrations. It took place fifty days after **Passover** (perhaps the most important of the three major celebrations). Another name for Pentecost is **Shavuot**. It was the spring harvest celebration for Jews. For Christians Pentecost has become the great feast of the **Holy Spirit** whose presence in fire and wind transformed the Apostles into men of action.
