## PARISH ANNOUNCEMENTS

- This week is celebrated the **Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross**, a feast which originally commemorated the dedication of Constantine's Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem. There the remains of the cross that St Helena had recently discovered were venerated. The following day we celebrate the **Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows**. We contemplate Mary who standing by the cross, 'suffered intensely with her only begotten Son and united herself to his sacrifice, consenting with love to the offering of the victim who was born of her', whom she offered to the eternal Father (*Marialis Cultus*). Also celebrated this week is the **Memorial of St John Chrysostom**, Bishop and Doctor of the Church, 347-407. He was a great preacher often referred to as 'John of the golden-mouth' and is the Patron saint of preachers. Also, the **Feast of St Ninian** who was born in Cumbria about the year 360. He was ordained Bishop in 394 in Rome. He and his disciples settled and preached the Gospel in Scotland. He died about 432 and was buried in Whithorn.
- Our Parish Community today thanks Fr Bernardine for his ministry during his time as Administrator of the parish. We wish him well as he returns home to take on his new responsibilities. At the same time the parish joyfully welcomes Fr Kevin Lawrie who on Monday begins his ministry as Parish Priest of St Teresa's Parish.**
