PARISH ANNOUNCEMENTS

- This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The commemoration of the death of the Blessed Virgin is known as the Assumption because of the tradition that her body did not decay but that she was raised up, body and soul, into heaven. This tradition, which had been present in the Church for many centuries, became a formally defined doctrine of the universal Church on 1st November 1950. On that occasion Pope Pius XII wrote: "Finally the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be more fully conformed to her son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of sin and death." (Munificentissimus Deus). On Friday will be celebrated the Memorial of St Bernard, Abbot, 1090-1153. He became a Cistercian monk in 1113 and was chosen Abbot of Clairvaux in 1115. His writings reveal a solid grasp of biblical studies, spiritual theology and philosophy. On Saturday will be celebrated the Memorial of St Pius X, 1835-1914. He was the Cardinal Patriarch of Venice before being elected Pope in 1903. He encouraged pastoral liturgy and sacramental practice, especially of frequent communion, to which he admitted young children.
