A Time for Prayer and Reflection

We all may already be aware that as part of measures to halt the spread of the Coronavirus (Covid-19) all public Liturgies and Devotions in our Churches have been cancelled until further notice. These are unprecedented and troubling times. May we be encouraged to go through this period with a deep faith and trust in God.

A time such as this calls for fervent prayers and deep reflection. Let us remember to pray especially for the sick, those caring for them and those in position of responsibility who have difficult decisions to make. St Teresa's church will remain open during the day for people to come in and say their prayers in private.

NB: Please always wash your hands each time you enter or leave the church. Soap and water are available in the toilets at the back of the church. You can also use the hand gel provided at the back of the church.

Daily Masses

While all public Masses are suspended Fr Bernardine will continue to celebrate Mass privately and daily for your intentions. Those who may wish to request Masses (for the Dead, Anniversaries, Months Mind, Sick, other intentions) will still be able to do so. You may drop your Mass requests into the box provided at the back of the church or slip them through the door of the chapel house.

The Sacraments

Anyone who needs the Sacrament of Confession or who just needs a priest to talk to should feel free to contact Fr Bernardine. Fr Bernardine will also be available to visit the sick and house bound for the Sacrament of Anointing and Holy Communion.

Parish Finances
