Unveiling a statue of Saint Gianna Beretta Molla, Patron Saint of Unborn Children

"As to the past, let us entrust it to God's mercy, the future to divine Providence. Our task is to live holy the present moment."

Join the Society for the Protection of Unborn Children as they ask for Saint Gianna's intercession for the pro-life movement in the UK. Saint Gianna was a 20th century wife, mother, and doctor, most often remembered for her sacrificial love for her unborn daughter. She is a patron for mothers, physicians, and unborn children. To commemorate her holy life, and ask for her intercession, a new statue will be unveiled at Carfin Grotto, Scotland's National Shrine on **Thursday 28 April 2022 at 7.00pm** with Mass then taking place at **7.30pm**.
