Coronavirus (Covid-19) Emergency

The rapid spread of the Coronavirus (Covid-19) has led to an almost complete lockdown in our country. All public Liturgies and Devotions in our churches have been suspended and, sadly but necessarily so, the doors of our churches have closed for the unforeseeable future.
